**OPENING-** The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Smedley at 7:02 PM. Mayor asked the council to review their copies of the last minutes and tonight's agenda with the addition of item D under new business the awarding of the storm water contract. Nielson moved to approve the minutes from June 8, 2011 and the agenda. Lawson seconded the motion, all voted aye.

### **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION-**

- A. Building permit extension at 7216 NW Prairie View was reviewed; plans were submitted the resident stated he will have the exterior finished by September 14<sup>th</sup> and the Aldermen agreed to that date. Hoover stated that she has received several complaints and that she cannot approve an extension. Nielson moved to grant the extension with the caveat that the final plans be submitted to the city by the end of July. Hoover voted nay, Nielson aye, Lawson nay. Hoover moved to extend the completion date to August 31<sup>st</sup> and plans due July 31. Hoover aye, Nielson aye, Lawson nay. Motion carried.

**MAYOR'S REMARKS**- Mayor asked Nielson to look into the fireworks ordinance. Yard waste dumpster was discussed. Home's Association dinner is Friday night. Police Chief's position will be advertised in MML magazine.

**NEW BUSINESS**-

- A. Ordinance 815 was read by title only twice by clerk. Nielson moved to approve Lawson seconded all voted aye.
- B. 2011-2012 Budget & Levy Setting was discussed. Hoover moved, Nielson seconded all voted aye. Levy will remain the same.
- C. 2011 Board Appointments will be Hausner and Hooper to be reappointed for new 5 year terms. All approved.
- D. Storm water contract will be awarded to Anderson Backhoe not to exceed \$29,000. Hoover moved, Nielson seconded all voted aye.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS**- Thompson wants the city to swear in officers as the election results had only been read. Thompson also wants sewer bills to be rated by usage rather than have the rate evenly distributed between the residents. Shoemaker asked for a timeline on a potential fireworks ordinance. Stoeger asked for status update on Winstead. Thompson also asked about additional liquor licenses for a potential tenant.

**ADJOURNMENT**- Hoover motioned to adjourn meeting, seconded by Lawson, all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 9:10 pm. The next meeting will be held on August 10, 2011 at 7:00pm.
