OPENING- The meeting was called to order by Mayor Smedley at 7:00 pm. Smedley asked the Council to review their copies of the December 12, 2018 meeting minutes and today's agenda. Mayor asked for a motion to approve the minutes from December 12, 2018, and today's agenda. Alderman Hoover motioned to approve, Alderman Lawson seconded the motion, all voted aye.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION-

POLICE REPORT-

-Chief Kerns gave the report on police activity for December 2018.

COURT REPORT-

-A. Moore presented the December 2018 court report, with \$9,106.69 in total revenue and 63 cases disposed. Mayor announced starting March 2019 the Municipal Court will be held the first Tuesday of the month at 6:30pm.

COMMITTEE REPORTS AND ALDERMEN'S REMARKS

-Alderman Hoover expressed her appreciation for the Police Department services, which include checking her house while on vacation.

-Alderman Cory asked the Alderman and staff their opinions about a business in Platte Woods selling CBD oil. Neither Chief Kerns nor the Alderman expressed any concerns.

-Mayor shared on behalf of the Park Committee that the kitchen is complete except for flooring which will be finished soon. Mayor also shared that the Platte County Park Grant application is due by January 18, 2019 at 5pm. Considerations are still being made on whether Platte Woods will submit an application.

FINANCIAL REPORTS-

-J. Hull gave the report on the financial documents. There are no concerns with Paybills resolution, cashflow or budget vs. actual documents. Alderman White motioned to approve Paybills Resolution #1-10-19, Alderman Lawson seconded. All voted aye.

MAYOR'S REMARKS-

-Mayor mentioned that the Storm Grant applications are due March 15, 2019

-Mayor shared that the bids for 72nd Street opened up on Tuesday, January 15, 2019.

Construction is to begin in March 2019, which will close off 72nd street just east of Waukomis

-Mayor stated that the Platte County Mayors met on January 2, 2019. Pat Klein will speak about the new KCI Airport Terminal plans on February 6, 2019.
